Andy's Family

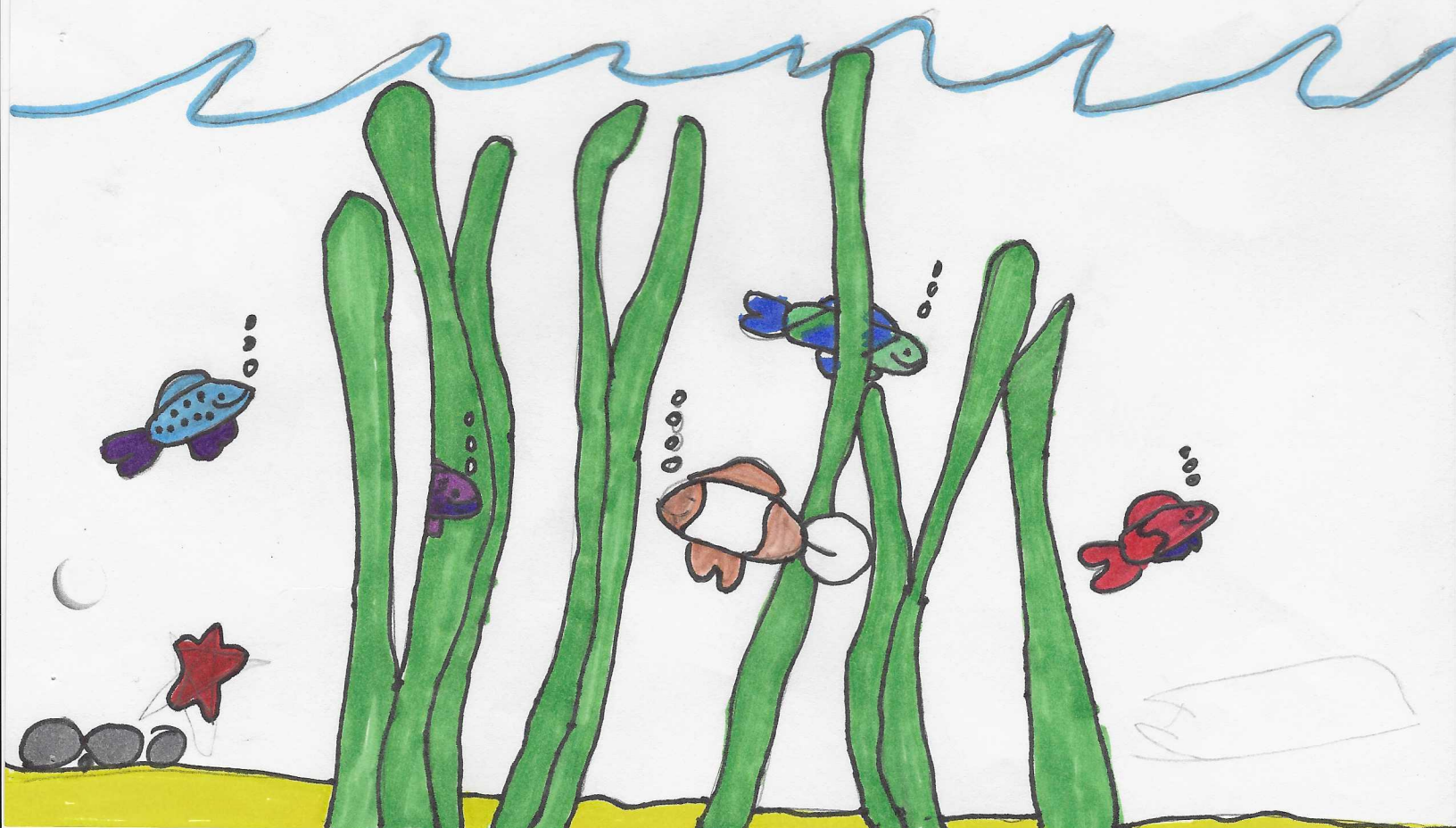
While visiting with my Grandpa, Andy, I really enjoyed learning about my Grandpa's family. To start, his youngest son is becoming a professor in physics in Canada.
